

**Augment Human Computer Interaction Lab (AHCIL)

License Agreement**

**Introduction:**

The goal of our speech research is to develop robust speech technology based system for various languages. As a part of this research, we are involved in ongoing effort to collect the speech samples for these Language in specific domains. The database is meant to aid research efforts in the general area of developing, training, testing and evaluating speech recognition algorithms for Indian languages. The Augmented Human Computer Interaction Lab, (henceforth, AHCIL ) owns copyright of the collection speech samples and serves as the source for the speech database for various languages of Marathwada Region and is now distributed to any research group approved by the AHCIL In-charge.

**Release of the Database:**

To advance the Speech technology for Indian languages and specifically for Marathi language, The Speech and Emotional Speech Database will be made available to the researchers on a case-by-case basis. All requests for the Speech and Emotional Speech database must be submitted in writing to the AHCIL In-charge by the researcher's institution on behalf of the Individual researcher or research unit (henceforth, the "Researcher").Requests must be directed to the AHCIL In-charge and the In-charge's decision regarding access are final. To receive a copy of the database, the authorized Researcher must sign this document along with signature of the Head of Department or Director of Institute and agree to observe the following guidelines. In addition to other possible remedies, failure to observe these guide lines may result in revocation of permission to use the data as well as denial of access to databases in future. The AHCIL database will be made available to researchers via an Internet source. There will be no charge for speech samples made available and downloaded via the Internet.

**Consent:**

The researcher(s) agrees to the following guide lines on the AHCIL Speech Database:

1. Without prior approval from the AHCIL In-charge, the AHCIL speech database, in whole or in part, will not be further distributed, published, copied, or disseminated in any way or form whatsoever, whether for profit or not. This includes further distributing, copying or disseminating to a different facility or organizational unit within the requesting University, organization or company.
2. Modification and Commercial Use: Without prior approval from the AHCIL, the speech database, in whole or in part, may not be modified or used for commercial purposes.
3. Requests for the Speech Database: All the requests for the AHCIL Speech Database should be forwarded to the AHCIL In-Charge.
4. Citation: All documents and papers that report on research that uses the AHCIL Speech Database must acknowledged and cited for use of the database by including an appropriate citation.
5. Publication to AHCIL: A copy of all reports and papers that are for public or general release that use the AHCIL Speech Database must be forwarded immediately upon release or publication to AHCIL In-charge.
